

SIERRA AWNING

These measuring instructions are recommended at all times when measuring for the Sierra awning.

Following these instructions each time will ensure a proper fit and give you a consistent installation.

If for any reason these instructions will not work for your situation. Please request technical assistance at 877.792.1775 to ensure fit.



MEASURE WIDTH

- Before measuring check opening for any obstructions or extreme variations in wall surfaces.
- Create diagram of opening to be measured.
- Measure opening width in 3 places: Top, Center and Bottom.
- Write measurements on diagram.
- Measure opening a second time to verify correct measurements.
- **ADD 8 inches to the widest measurement of the width opening.** This will be your width measurement.

PROJECTION & ARM PLACEMENT

- Determine whether the awning will extend up to a 90° projection or extend up to a full 180° projection.

90° PROJECTION

180° PROJECTION



Awning arms mounted at 1/2 the height of opening.



HANDING

- Manual Sierra: Determine the handing as if you were operating the awning. Stand where the awning is operated, are you on the left or right of the awning?
- Motorized Sierra: Determine where the power will come from and specify the motor on that side of the awning.

Please use these instructions as a guideline when measuring for your Sierra Awning and remember the most important thing is that the fabric and/or awning arms don't rub and wear on the mounting surface and you have an appropriate surface to mount the brackets.
